First-Time Sign-In

When you sign in for the first time, you must set up your mailbox. To access your VM, dial the access number

* 1 7 from your phone.

First-time sign-in involves three steps:

- changing your pin
- · recording your name
- choosin g a greeting

The greeting and recorded name are played each time a caller accesses your mailbox to leave a message.

Changing your PIN

First, to secure your amount, you must set up a new PIN. A prompt asks you to enter a new PIN, which can range between 4-20 digits.

- 1. Enter a new PIN, pressing # when finished.
- 2. Confirm the new PIN by re-entering it and pressing # When finished

Recording your name

Next, you are prompted to record your name. This will be used for some system-generated announcements, for example when greeting your callers or when you leave messages for others.

Your recording should be less than ten seconds long. If it is too long, you will be asked to re-record a shorter version.

- 1. Record your name and press # when finished.
- 2. An announcement plays your recording back to you.
 - If you want to re-record it, press 1.
 - If you want to keep it, press # .

Choosing a greeting

Once you have successfully recorded your name, you are prompted to select a greeting. You can use a number of different types of greetings.

- To record your own personal greeting, press 1.
 Then record your personal greeting, pressing #.
 when finished.
- To use a system-generated greeting that announces your recorded name, press 2 .
- To use a system-generated greeting that reads out your phone number, press 3.
- To use a system-generated greeting that neither announces your name nor reads out your phone number, press 4.

An announcement plays back your selected greeting

- To record or select a different greeting press 1.
- To save it and use it as your greeting, press #.

This is the last step in setting up your mailbox.

Message Waiting Notification

After a new message enters your mailbox, you will hear a special "stutter" dial tone when you lift your telephone receiver. You may make other calls even when you hear the stutter dial tone. Simply dial as usual. After you retrieve all new messages, the normal dial tone is automatically restored.

Accessing Your Mailbox

(after setting up your voice mailbox)

To access your voice mailbox from your telephone number associated with your voice mail service:

- 1. Dial * 1 7
- 2. Enter your pass code.
- 3.follow the instruction prompts

To access your voice mail when you are not at the telephone number associated with your voice mailbox:

1. Dial one of the folowing retrieval numbers: (MAIL is 6245)

AIL IS 6245) 830-336-MAIL

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830-885-MAIL 830-236-MAIL

830-437-MAIL

830-904-MAIL(from New Braunfules)

830-980-MAIL (from San Antonio)

When traveling, use our main retrieval #830-438-MAIL

- 2. Enter the 10-digit telephone number associated with your voice mailbox when prompted to enter your mailbox number.
 - Press * during the greeting.
 - · Follow the instrustion prompts.

Follow typical long-distance procedures if appropriate. Long distance charges will apply, you may use a long distance calling card when acessing the system.

Within your calling area, you may also check messages by calling your home number and pressing *.

NOTE: If you subscribe to Per Line Blocking, it must be deactivated to access your Voice Mailbox. Dial * 8 2 before the retrieval number, if applicable.

Playing A Message

- Access your mailbox (see "Accessing Your Voice Mailbox").
- 2. Press 11 to review messages
 - Press 1 to repeat the message
 - Press 2 to save the message
 - Press 3 to delete the message
 - Press # to mark saved message as new
 - Press * to exit

User Options

Your Voice Mailbox options may be changed anytime you have accessed your voice mailbox.

Greetings Menu

- Access your mailbox (see "Accessing Your Voice Mailbox").
- 2. Press 3 for the Greetings Menu
 - Press 11 for personal greeting
 - Press 3 for system-generated greeting or record name
 - Press 5 for busy greeting
 - Press * to exit

Pin change

- Access your mailbox (see "Accessing Your Voice Mailbox").
- 2. Press 3 for the Mailbox Settings Menu
 - Press 3 for security options
 - Press 1 for pin change
