

CUSTOMER NOTICE

Guadalupe Valley Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (GVTC) has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) seeking approval to modify rates in certain of the Cooperative's exchanges. GVTC proposes to increase basic local residential access line rates in certain exchanges. GVTC's application has been assigned Project No. 47597.

The proposed rate modifications apply to residential customers in the GVTC exchanges listed below. The proposed effective date for the new rates is January 1, 2018. The estimated intrastate gross annual revenue impact to GVTC is an increase of \$96.950.

The proposed modified access line rates are as follows:

If the Commission receives protest(s) regarding this proposal from 5% of the affected local service customers to which this proposal applies, by December 25, 2017, the application may be docketed. The 5% limitation will be calculated based upon the total number of customers of record as of the calendar month preceding the Commission's receipt of the protest(s). As of August 02, 2017, the 5% limitation equated to 1,174 customers.
