### **GVTC moving its Gonzales-area operations back to Cost**

SMITHSON VALLEY, July 30, 2014 — GVTC is helping the Gonzales County Tax Assessor-Collector get some much needed office space sooner than later. In discussions with Gonzales County Judge David Bird, GVTC has agreed to end its lease at the Randall-Rather building by November 30, 2014.

GVTC's five-year lease wasn't set to expire until June 2017. However, the dynamics of the lease changed when Gonzales County became the new landlord of the Randall-Rather building earlier this year. The county purchased the building with the intention of relocating its tax assessor-collector operations, which has significantly outgrown its current location.

"As a good corporate citizen, we understand the tax assessor-collector's office is in an urgent situation to expand its building capacity," Jeff Mnick, GVTC vice president, sales and marketing, said. "I'm very pleased we could work something out that benefits both parties."

GVTC will move its Gonzales-based employees back to its Cost facility by the November timetable. The Cost location will function exclusively as a call center and will not be open to customer traffic.

"We're back in Cost but we'll continue to have a strong presence in Gonzales working with the community to promote the GVTC GigaRegion™ and giving back through The GVTC Foundation," GVTC CEO Ritchie Sorrells, said. "We are evaluating our options and leaving the door open for a return to Gonzales, should an opportunity present itself."
